



Sutton Courtenay Parish Council

The following is a summary of the CIL and non specified S106 allocations as approved by Council at the November 2021 meeting

The Working Party considered the projects which were marked the three highest priorities in the last resident's survey carried out being recreational facilities, footpaths and the Village Hall and requested information from relevant committees or Council working parties as to what level of expenditure should be considered.

It then considered the timescales for projects and the expiry dates of the CIL and Section 106 monies when allocating.

A further £100k of CIL money is expected in 2 tranches in July 2022 and July 2023 and further funding may be available for the below projects when these monies are received. The council will consider allocating future CIL monies once confirmation of the funds being paid over has been received to avoid shortfalls in project funding if there is a delay.
