

**NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER  
SECTION 53 OF THE WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for Oxfordshire  
Sutton Courtenay Footpath No. 33 Modification Order 2021**

The above Order made on the 20 September 2021, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by: -

*Adding to them the footpath from Sutton Courtenay Bridleway 3 at SP 5059 9417, running (generally) east-south-easterly for approximately 275m, then running south-south-westerly for approximately 196 metres to the junction with Sutton Courtenay Footpath 12.*

If the order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
